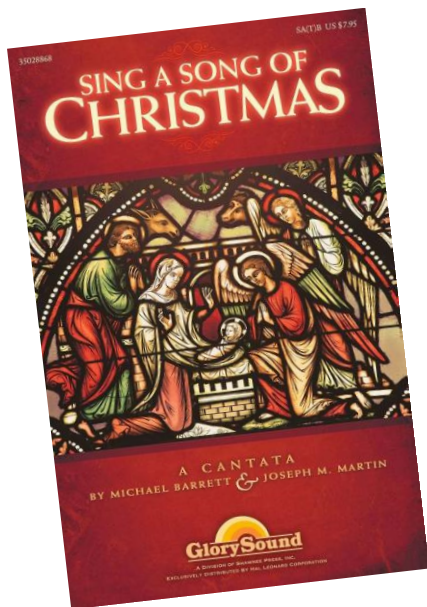


Christmas Cantata
